A varied menu including many different fresh fruits and vegetables, whole grain and made from scratch items are offered.

As a participant in the **USDA National School Lunch Program (NSLP)**, we offer free or reduced-price (\$0.40) lunches for qualifying families. This applies to one lunch per student per day. (Milk only not eligible for free.) Applications and information are available online at <https://sjbplymouth.org/Lunch-Program> or from the school or parish offices. Contact the Principal or Director of Administrative Services if you have any questions.

Through generous Angel Fund donations, families qualified for free/reduced lunch **are eligible for free regular single-day fieldtrips** *Choice students do not pay for regular fieldtrips.

Overnight trips excluded. Parent/guardian permission is required, see "Field Trip Assistance" form.



Payments may be made online by logging into FACTS and adding funds to your [PrePay Accounts](#). Cash or check payment may be made directly to the school office.

Sycamore is used to charge and track lunch and milk items. Family accounts enable parents to view their child(ren)'s daily charges and see current balance by logging in and navigating to →*My Accounting* →*Cafeteria* →*Account*. Please select the YEAR and month you wish to view. The default is the current month and year.



Families are responsible for maintaining a positive balance in their lunch/milk accounts. Low Balance Notifications will be emailed to families. We encourage families who may have difficulty paying for lunch to please complete a free and reduced lunch application or contact the Principal or Director of Administrative Services for temporary assistance. Children will not be denied a meal. However, if a lunch account has a negative balance of \$100 the parent/guardians' FACTS account will be charged.

SNACK MILK – Kindergarten – 8th grade

Snack milk is available through the SJB Lunch Program.* The cost is **\$32.45** per trimester, per student, billed through FACTS. Once ordered, it will renew for the year unless cancelled prior to the new trimester.

Fieldtrip Lunches

Cold lunches are available when fieldtrips take students out over their lunch period. **Lunches must be pre-ordered.** These lunches are charged at the standard lunch price and are eligible at the free or reduced rate to qualified families.

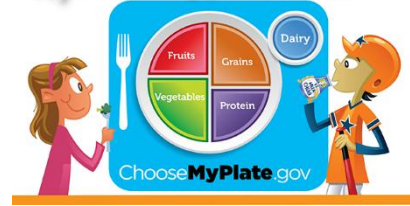
